Fleadh Fest 2021



In the February -- March issue of this newsletter we told you about a project that Comhaltas-Ireland instituted, requesting that we provide the history of our branch as part of the West Region of North America.

Due to Covid-19, there will not be any live events such as the annual Fleadh Chéoil na hÉireann in 2021. Instead, all Comhaltas branches are asked to submit the story of their branch. We are working with the other 6 branches in our West Region (Oregon, Phoenix, Los Angeles, San Diego, Puget Sound and Albuquerque) to put this 2 hour presentation together. When finished, the story will be incorporated into a production by Irish Television TG-4 (Teilifís na Gaeilge) and will be made available for viewing world-wide.

The Fleadh Fest committee has been working tirelessly on information gathered, editing videos, photos and stories. While this particular "Fleadh Fest" project is limited in scope, it has made us realize that we do not have an organized archive of our branch's 45+ year history.

We will be putting another committee together to seek out the best way to do this. You are all invited to participate...either by providing any archive experience you may have and/or sending us your photos, videos, stories and memories of the SF Cooley-Keegan Branch.

We are sure you have a lot to share. It will serve as a platform for our 50th anniversary coming soon!

We then advertised it as a 2020-2021 draw, not realizing that CCE intended to have another draw this year in November for new 2021 tickets.

So, the tickets which we sold are for 2020. 100% of the proceeds of this draw are kept by the branch for 2020 only. We sincerely appreciate all those who purchased tickets. The "2020" Draw will be held in Ireland the beginning of May. Our own "Local" draw for four prizes of \$25.00 each will be held at "Wawona Gates" at the United Irish Cultural Center on Saturday, May 22, 2021 at 4pm. 


