From Our Youth Officer

By volunteering at a family shelter and juvenile detention center, I realized that I could make a big impact on society. In the juvie, I played dodgeball with kids who are in for sexual assault to murder. By treating them as kids, not criminals, it will help them find a better pathway in life. In doing this small act, I may have been able to help them change their lives.

This trip helped me understand the importance of reaching out to my greater community in order to help those who feel like they don't have a second chance at life.
